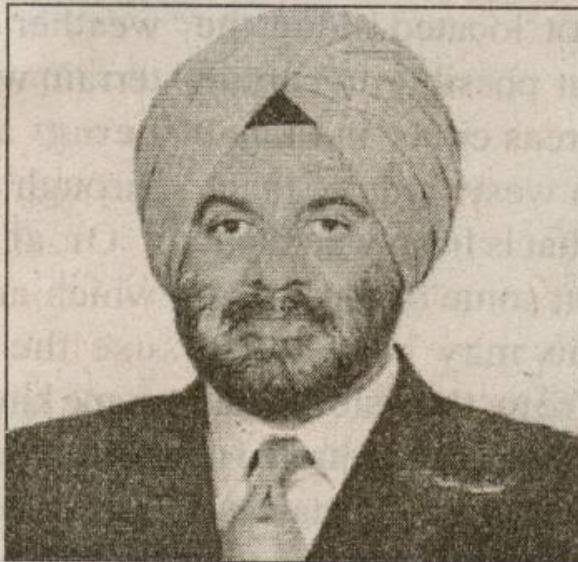

Governor plays Good Samaritan



ITANAGAR, Feb 7: In his yet another venture towards the development of this hilly State, Governor General J J Singh played a Good Samaritan to facilitate the Arunachal Pradesh govt in getting a plot of defence land at Hayuliang under Anjaw district for establishment of

District Hospital there.

On a request made by Finance Minister Kalikho Pul, Gen Singh took up the matter with the Union Defence Ministry and facilitated the transfer of the land, measuring 42.66 acres, from the jurisdiction of Indian Army.

It is for the first time in the history of this border State that a prime land of the Defence is being handed over to state govt. The said land, which is well developed by the Army and classified as category A-1, will be used for setting up of the proposed District Hospital, the foundation stone of which was laid by the Governor at Swamy Camp, Hayuliang on January 17 last.
