From P.1... On his arrival at Sela Pass, Singh was accorded a warm reception by the Tawang deputy commissioner Gamli Padu, SP Norbu Mosobi, Jung ADC Duli Kamduk and others.

Fourteen kms Sela, towards Tawang, the former chief of the Indian Army paid homage to Mahavir Chakra awardee late Jaswant Singh at the famous Jaswant Ghar, a war memorial raised in his memory. Jaswant Ghar is a place where patriotic emotions of all Indians find natural expression.

Before reaching Tawang, the governor stopped at the famous Nuranang or Jung waterfalls. He advised the senior officials there to make it more appealing to the tourists and guests visiting the district.
