**Governor meets Union Home Minister**

**Governor emphasises on strengthening the State Police**

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Brig. (Dr.) B.D. Mishra (Retd.) met the Union Home Minister Shri Amit Shah in the National Capital New Delhi on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2019. They discussed about the security scenario of the State, particularly the eastern districts of Namsai, Changlang, Tirap and Longding.

The Governor emphasised on strengthening the State Police through Police modernization, provide adequate fund for accommodation facilities to the lower level personnel of the State Police Force and mobility. He also stressed on upgradation of riot control training and riot control equipments.
