Governor visits Arunachal Bhavan, Kolkata

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Brig. (Dr.) B. D. Mishra (Retd.), who is on a three-day official visit to Kolkata, visited the Arunachal Bhavan, Kolkata on 14th December 2019. He interacted with the officials and staff of the Bhavan inspected the kitchen and dormitories for men and women.

The Governor advised the officials to facilitate the inflow of tourists to Arunachal Pradesh and showcase the best indigenous handlooms and handicrafts of the State. He also asked them to assist the people coming from the State for medical, official work and education to Kolkata and advised them to go beyond the call of duty as facilitators for the transiting people at Kolkata from Arunachal Pradesh to ensure their safety, security and wellbeing.

Overall cleanliness and maintenance of the Arunachal Bhavan were good except the dormitories and its washrooms for men and women. He directed the officials stationed to improve the beds and toilets there. He advised them to refurbish the dormitories, provide more cots and cupboards for men and women.

The Governor was conducted around the Bhavan, and briefed by the Deputy Resident Commissioner Shri S. Nath. He also visited the tourism office and State Emporium of Arunachal Pradesh in the building.

Later in the day, the Governor met the Governor of West Bengal, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar at Raj Bhavan, Kolkata.
