Governor reviews preparation for APPSC examinations

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Brig. (Dr.) B. D. Mishra (Retd.) reviewed the preparation for the ensuing Arunachal Pradesh Public Service Commission (APPSC) Preliminary Combined Competitive Examination in different parts of the State, at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 29th October 2020.

The Governor emphasised that all steps must be taken in advance to ensure free and fair conduct of the preliminary examination by APPSC. He said that every official including those of APPSC and District Administration must take full responsibility and they will be held accountable to conduct the examination in a foolproof manner.

The Governor said that APPSC examinations are the most important competitive examinations of the State. The best and most meritorious candidates are selected through its process. Therefore, it is mandatory that the procedure must be transparent, above board. No copying, impersonation, or malpractice in writing answers should be allowed in the examination centres. In these matters, there must be no loose ends, he said.

The Governor advised the State Chief Secretary and Director General of Police to take all actions for the proper conduct of the examination. He also asked the APPSC members to monitor and ensure proper conduct of every stage of the examination.

Chairman, APPSC Shri Nipo Nabam and member APPSC, Major General GS Bisht, VSM (Retd.) briefed the Governor about the arrangements for the ensuing APPSC Prelim, which will be conducted on 1st November 2020. The examination will be conducted at 126 examination sub centres including 52 in the Capital region. 26,480 candidates will be appearing for the Prelims.

State Chief Secretary Shri Naresh Kumar, IAS and Director General of Police Shri R.P. Upadhyaya, IPS, BSNL General Manager Shri Arung Siram, and Director, Department of Telecom, Shri H.L. Nongkhlaw participated in the discussion. Commissioner to Governor Dr. Sagar Preet Hooda, IPS was also present in the meeting.
