Governor expresses displeasure over certain interpretations of his remarks

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh has expressed displeasure over certain interpretations of his remarks regarding the situation in the Taksing area of Upper Subansiri district in the print media. It has been observed that some narratives have incorrectly projected that Lok Bhavan has acknowledged an intrusion into Indian territory. This is **NOT** the position conveyed by the Governor.

The Governor discussed all issues raised by AAPSU and Tagin community, over 'two hours', dispelling their perceptions. He assured these organizations of safety and security of the frontier population, being undertaken by the Army troops deployed in this sector. The press statement only talks of the memo presented by them.

The Governor has categorically stated that there is **NO NEW INTRUSION** in the Taksing area. His observations were made in the context of public concerns and reports that have surfaced from time to time regarding the border region. Any suggestion that Lok Bhavan has endorsed claims of fresh intrusion and he will pursue with the defence and Home Ministries and the Prime Minister is a malicious misinterpretation of his remarks.

It is pertinent to note that the position articulated by the Governor is consistent with the statements made by Union Minister Shri Kiren Rijiju, Chief Minister Shri Pema Khandu and the Indian Army, all of whom have rejected reports of any fresh intrusion into Arunachal Pradesh. Similarly, Chief Minister Shri Pema Khandu has categorically rejected reports of a fresh Chinese incursion in the Taksing sector, emphasizing that the Indian Army is deployed in the area and is effectively safeguarding the nation's borders. He stated that there was no reason to believe that an intrusion had taken place and assured that any claims would be independently verified with local stakeholders and the Army.

The Governor has full confidence in the vigilance, professionalism and operational preparedness of the Indian Armed Forces, which remain committed to safeguarding every inch of the nation's territory. The Government of India has consistently demonstrated its resolve to protect national sovereignty and territorial integrity, while maintaining robust mechanisms for addressing border-related issues.
