Governor appreciates Tani Lipi

Itanagar, Aug 11: State Governor Gen J.J Singh is in all appreciation for the efforts put on by Tony Koyu in developing Tani Lipi as a common script for the people of the state.

Congratulating Koyu, who called on the Governor along with the members of North East Development Welfare Society at Raj bhawan here this evening, Singh termed it as a right step in bringing various tribes under a single banner and a common platform. He considered Koyu's contribution as historical in the history of Arunachal Pradesh.

The Governor further advised them to approach the state government for placing the proposal of adopting Tani Lipi as the state script in the Assembly.
