## Governor reviews law and order situation of the state

**Itanagar, October 6:** The Governor today sought a detailed briefing from the law-enforcing authorities of the State on the present law and order position in the State and the Capital complex in particular, *reports PRO to Governor*.

The Commissioner (Home), Director General of Police, IG (Police) and DIG (Intelligence) called on the Governor at Raj Bhawan here today and briefed him on the certain recent developments in Itanagar and Naharlagun.

The Governor also expressed his concern on the recent unfortunate incident in Roing and wished for an early recovery of the injured officials, policemen and the citizens. He was informed that a high-level committee will soon be set-up to enquire into the issue.

While advising the senior officers to take all steps to ensure public order and uphold the rule of law, the Governor stressed that it was important to monitor the situation very closely. Arunachal Pradesh has been an oasis of peace in the entire Northeastern region and it is important that the atmosphere of fraternity, harmony and tranquillity prevailing in the State is not vitiated by forces with vested interests, he added, *the report added*.
