**AICPMFEWA members calls on Governor**

**ITANAGAR, October 30:** The executive members of All India Central Para-Military Forces Ex-Servicemen Welfare Association (AICPMFEWA), Arunachal Pradesh committee called on the state Governor General (Retd) J.J Singh at Raj Bhavan here today and submitted a seven-point memorandum to the Governor.

Interacting with the members of AICPMFEWA, the Governor assured to look into the issues related to their welfare programmes as announced by Ministry of Home Affairs. He also agreed to take up with the state chief minister to ensure that former personnel of Para-Military forces get their dues as their colleagues are getting in other states. The Governor also conveyed his good wishes for the ensuing first general conference of AICPMFEWA Arunachal Pradesh chapter, but expressed his regret that he would not be able to attend due to his preoccupation.

Earlier, AICPMFEWA state committee President Dr. Nima Taye gave a brief background of the AICPMFEWA. He apprised the Governor that there are around 500 pensioners of Para-Military forces and informed that the state level Ex-Servicemen General Conference will be held at State Banquet Hall, Itanagar on November 7 next, which would be attended by AICPMFEWA National Secretary P.S Nair.

AICPMFEWA state committee Vice President, Honi Tazing and its office Secretary Er Timothy Nima were also present in the meeting.
