TUKI CALLS ON GOVERNOR

DISCUSSES LAW AND ORDER AND DEVELOPMENT RELATED ASPECTS

Itanagar, 28 April: As a part of regular interaction to update His Excellency the Governor on the various developmental initiatives, PM Package Projects and law and order scenario in the State, the Chief Minister Shri Nabam Tuki called on His Excellency the Governor General J.J. Singh at Raj Bhavan today. During the one hour long meeting, several critical issues such as Itanagar Greenfield Airport, Miao-Vijaynagar road, setting up of additional NCC units and a Sainik School in the State were discussed. The Chief Minister also briefed the Governor on the steps being taken by the State Govt. to improve the law and order scenario with particular reference to the insurgent activities in Tirap, Changlang and Longding Districts.

His Excellency the Governor appreciated the Chief Minister for undertaking extensive tours to the remote and far-flung areas of the State which showed his personal commitment to the development of these areas.
