Union Minister of Road Transport and Highways Shri Oscar Fernandes called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt General (Retd) Nirbhay Sharma at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2013. Discussion took place on various issues related to roads and highways of Arunachal Pradesh.

Highlighting the importance of good conditioned roads for the overall development of the State viz. Health, Education, Transport, Tourism, Trade and Commerce etc., HE the Governor emphasized timely completion of the ongoing roads and highway projects, in the State.

The Governor expressed the requirement of single window clearances from MoEF to reduce the inordinate delays in the projects. Further the Governor also felt there should be a single agency for effective monitoring of all the roads & highway projects undergoing in the State.

The issue of timely submission of DPRs, Technical Evaluation of projects, inclusion of certain critical machineries/equipments and co-ordination with BSNL etc. were touched upon in the discussion.
