Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Lt. Gen (Retd) Nirbhay Sharma who is on an official tour to Delhi for the two-day 'Conference of the Governors' met the family members of Late Nido Tania, including Parliamentary Secretary for Health and Family Welfare, Food and Civil Supplies, Shri Nido Provitro and Smt Nido Marina at Arunachal House, New Delhi on 14th February 2014. First Lady of the State Smt Jyotsna Sharma was present on the occasion. Member of Pariament (Lok Sabha) Shri Takam Sanjay who accompanied the family members during the meeting briefed the Governor about the 10-point memorandum to Prime Minister of India and others.

Sharing their grief, the first couple expressed sincere condolences to the family members and said that avoiding such instance in future would be real homage to Late Nido Tania.

Governor informed the family members that the issue was discussed during the Governors' Conference with the President and Prime Minister as well.

In his effort to ensure safety and security of students from Arunachal Pradesh, Governor met the Lt. Governor of Delhi Shri Najeeb Jung at New Delhi on 13th February 2014. He suggested that Delhi administration and Police must be more proactive and go out of their way to instil confidence among the denizens of Delhi from North East.

Governor suggested for exchange of programme for students and sensitization of police force for evolving better understanding of Northeast.

Governor asked Commissioner of Police, Delhi Shri Bhim Sain Bassi to ensure the safety and security of the students from Northeast region in general and Arunachal Pradesh in particular. He advised the Commissioner of Police, who was posted in Arunachal Pradesh in early 1980s to understand the psyche of the people from the region and take extra care in dealing with them.
