The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Lt. Gen (Retd) Nirbhay Sharma has expressed his deep concern on the increasing incidents of violence relating to the people of North Eastern India in the National Capital, particular in the two cases where a lady advocate and a nurse from Arunachal Pradesh were assaulted.

In this regard, the Governor spoke to Lieutenant Governor of Delhi, Shri Najeeb Jung over telephone on 19th September 2014 and requested him to take up the matters on priority in order to expedite the investigation.

The Governor said that a large number of people from Arunachal Pradesh especially students goes to the National Capital to pursue higher studies or for seeking jobs. Cases of physical injury including murders, assaults and many other discriminating and prejudicial incidents have to be stopped by all means. He emphasized on measures for augmenting their safety in order to restore confidence and faith amongst the people from the North Eastern region particularly from Arunachal Pradesh.
