The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Lt Gen (Retd) Nirbhay Sharma met the representatives of State Public Works Department, Border Road Organisation and Ministry of Road Transport & Highway at Raj Bhawan, Itanagar on 3rd December 2014.

The Governor asked to three agencies to make a working plan for road construction in the next five years and chart their programme accordingly.
