Governor monitoring search & rescue operation; asks to intensify operation

ITANAGAR, August 5, 2015: The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Shri JP Rajkhowa expressing grave concern over the missing helicopter in which Tirap Deputy Commissioner Kamlesh Joshi and two pilots were on board, has asked to further intensify search & rescue operations. The Governor has been constantly monitoring the situation and is being updated on the progress of the rescue operation by the Chief Secretary Ramesh Negi.

He was also apprised by the Chief Minister Shri Nabam Tuki that all possible steps have been taken and the Civil Administration, Police Army, CAPF, Airforce and the local populace are continuing the search operations to track the missing helicopter.

The Governor also spoke to Lt.Gen Bipin Rawat, GOC 3 Corps and discussed the situation on ground. He asked all the concerned authorities to cooperate and extend all out support for the search and rescue operations.
