GOVERNOR CALLS UPON TO PEOPLE TO COME FORWARD TO HELP THE NEEDY AND DOWNTRODDEN

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Shri JP Rajkhowa attended the fifth foundation day of 'Seneh', a Non-Governmental Organisation under Bhabada Devi Philanthropic Trust, working for the benefit of the homeless and destitute of the society, particularly women of North East India at Guwahati on 7th November 2015.

The Governor lauded the NGO, which is led by Gp Capt (Retd) Atul Chandra Barua ,VSM, who is the chairman of the Board of Trustees, for its efforts and rising to the call of the Society. He also commended the members of Seneh for addressing the challenges of the downtrodden and the inmates.

The Governor added that the regular financial assistance from 'GiveIndia' received by Seneh speaks of its credibility and recognition. 'GiveIndia' is a donation platform that allows interest people to support a cause of their choice from about 200 NGOs that have been scrutinised for transparency & credibility.

The Governor called upon to people to come forward to help the needy and downtrodden. They must help those disadvantaged people as individual and as a family, he added.
