Advisor calls on the Governor

The Advisor to Governor, Shri Y.S. Dadwal, former Delhi Police Commissioner called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Shri JP Rajkhowa at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 28th January 2016.
