We should not fail the people of the state: Governor on Chakma Hajong issue

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Shri JP Rajkhowa took strong exception to the poor performance of the State's Legal Team in the Chakma Hajong refugee issue. He has directed the Chief Secretary and the Principal Secretary Home to immediately hire the country's best lawyers to take up the matter in the Supreme Court.
