**Governor calls on the Railway Minister**

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Shri JP Rajkhowa met the Union Minister for Railways, Shri Suresh Prabhakar Prabhu, in New Delhi on March 16, 2016.

While conveying the gratitude of the people of the Frontier State for the intercity and express trains, the Governor called for increasing the frequencies and quality of both the train services. He also emphasised on expediting the work on strategic Railway lines initially to Tawang in the West and Pasighat in the East.
