Governor condoles, announces ex-gratia from Governor's relief fund

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Shri JP Rajkhowa has expressed shock and grieved the loss of lives in a massive landslide triggered by heavy rainfall at a place called Famla, 3 km from District Headquarters of Tawang.

Praying for the eternal peace of the departed souls, the Governor has announced an ex-gratia relief of Rs. 1 (One) lakh for the nearest kin or kins of each of sixteen workers died in the landslide.

The Governor has also condoled the death of 15 years old boy Dipak Deori of Namsai, who lost his life due to drowning in the Namsai flood. He announced an amount of Rs. 1 (One) lakh as ex-gratia. The amounts are sanctioned out of Governor's Relief Fund, which will be distributed through respective Deputy Commissioners.

The Governor called upon the people of the State to be alert and take necessary precautions as the State is experiencing heavy rainfall. He also advised the State Government and District Administrations to warn the people living in landslide and flood prone areas.
