Governor condoles and announces ex-gratia

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Sri JP Rajkhowa has expressed shock and grieved the death of Jubir Ahmed, who died when Eucalyptus tree fell in a kutch house, where he was staying during the cyclonic storm early this morning. He also prayed for early recovering of Md Taslimuddin, who was injured in the incident.

The Governor has announced an amount of Rs. 1 (One) lakh to the next to the kin of Jubir Ahmed and amount of Rs. 25 thousand to the injured one. The amount will be placed under Deputy Commissioner, Tirap District for disbursement.

The Governor has once again appealed to the people to take necessary precautions and more careful during natural calamities. He also advised the State Government and District Administration to take utmost care to ensure safety and security of the people and issue advisories in the form of do's and don't's in English, Hindi and other local languages for the benefit of common man.
