Governor stresses on improvement of professional knowledge and technical proficiency of police personnel

- State Home Minister Shri Kumar Waii called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Brig. (Dr.) B.D. Mishra (Retd) at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 30th October 2017. They discussed the overall law and order situation and other security related issues of the State.

- (d) Sharing his interactions with security officials, the Governor stressed on improvement of professional knowledge and technical proficiency of police personnel including their musketry training, deployed for the security duties in various sensitive locations.
