Chief Minister calls on the Governor

The Chief Minister Shri Pema Khandu called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Brig. (Dr.) B.D. Mishra (Retd.) at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 21st November 2021. They discussed about developmental projects and programmes.

The Governor shared his observations about Miao-Vijoyagar Road on which he drove on 20th November 2021. He emphasised that the project has to be expedited, while maintaining the quality of work with proper techniques and specifications as per the road construction work guidelines.

The Governor reiterated that this lifeline of the people of the easternmost tip of the State will be a boon for the youths, entrepreneurs and tourists.
