**Chief Minister calls on the Governor**

The Chief Minister Shri Pema Khandu called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Brig. (Dr.) B. D. Mishra (Retd.) at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2022. They discussed about developmental issues, COVID pandemic, law and order and education.
