The First Lady of the State, who learned loin loom weaving herself after coming to Arunachal Pradesh, said that traditional attires and loin loom weaving should give pride to our young sisters. She said it should become a fashion amongst the contemporary dress circles to claim that they are supporting and actively participating in our traditional weaving culture.

The First Lady of the State emphasized on Khadi for fashion. She said that fashion fusion of old and new will be a trendsetter and facilitate in taking our traditional weaving items **FROM LOCAL TO GLOBAL**.

The First Lady of the State stressed on linking the Self Help Group with the market so that it supports women empowerment and Atma Nirbharata. She called for support from business houses.

Director (Textile & Handicrafts) Shri Haj Dodung and Director (Sericulture) Ms. Barnali Sur also spoke on the occasion.

The models from Miss Arunachal Team **WALKED THE RAMP**. This was choreographed by Ms Duyir Ete. They display the loin loom weaved attires, designed and weaved by the First Lady of the State in the show. The Department of Textile and Handicrafts showcased the traditional attires of different tribes produced by the Department, while the Department of Sericulture presented Ahimsa Silk apparels. *The participating Self Help Groups also presented their collection in the fashion show where models walked the ramp displaying the various outfits.*
