Arunachal Pradesh Governor sworn-in as Governor of Meghalaya

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Brig. (Dr.) B. D. Mishra (Retd.) was sworn-in as the Governor of Meghalaya on 4th October 2022. The senior most Judge of the High Court of Meghalaya, Justice H.S. Thangkhi administered the oath of office to the Governor at the Durbar Hall of Raj Bhavan, Shillong.
