Governor reviews developmental programmes of Pakke Kessang

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Lt. General KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.) reviewed the developmental programmes and projects of Pakke Kessang District at Pakke Kessang on 7th July 2023.

The Governor exhorted the officials to have vision, both long term and short-term goals for development of the new district. He advised the officials to encourage and motivate the people for optimum use of their land to be self-reliant and realize the vision of Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's vision of Atma Nirbhar Bharat.

While stressing on giving priority to completion of the District Secretariat, the Governor emphasized on the importance of people and community participation for the progress of the District. The Governor expressed concern about the education in the district and called for taking necessary actions.
