The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Lt. General KT Parnaik, participated in the Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas, which commemorates the birthday of Bhagwan Birsa Munda, at Ziro in Lower Subansiri on 15th November 2023. The Governor paid a flowery tribute to a portrait of Bhagwan Birsa Munda and lit the inaugural lamp of the celebration. An exhibition of tribal heroes in the Indian Freedom Movement was displayed at Abo Tani Hall, Ziro. He distributed certificate and cash awards to the winners of the walkathon, organized on the occasion of Janjatiya Gaurav Diwas.

On the special occasion, the Governor launched the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra.
