Shri Amitabh Gupta, Inspector General, North East Frontier, Indo Tibetan Border Police, Itanagar, called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh Lt. General KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.) at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar on 9<sup>th</sup> January 2025. They discussed border security and management, vibrant village programme and other issues related to the State.
