Governor reviews PM Gatishakti

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt. General KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.), reviewed the implementation and utilization of PM GatiShakti in the State at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar, on 22nd November 2025.
