IMC Mayor calls on the Governor

The Mayor of the Itanagar Municipal Corporation, Smt Likha Nari Tadar, called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, at Lok Bhavan, Itanagar, on 17 February 2026. During the meeting, the Mayor, who represents Ward No. 16, shared her vision for the city's development and discussed the challenges faced in improving civic amenities and urban governance.
