Chief Minister calls on the Governor

State Chief Minister Shri Pema Khandu called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.) at Bumla Cottage, Tawang on 8th April 2026. They held detailed discussions on the forthcoming Deputy Commissioners' Conference scheduled to begin in Tawang from 9th April 2026, focusing on its agenda, expected outcomes, and the importance of district-level governance in driving development.

The Governor, who will address the Conference on 10th April 2026, expressed confidence that the conference would be purposeful and outcome-oriented, leading to concrete and actionable steps towards the vision of a Viksit Arunachal. He emphasized that Deputy Commissioners, being the key link between the government and the people, must focus on practical, district-specific solutions that ensure balanced and inclusive development across sectors.

They also held in-depth discussions on the overall development scenario of the State, identifying key sectors and critical areas that require urgent and focused attention. Emphasis was laid on strengthening infrastructure, alongside improving delivery in health, education, and rural development. They underscored the need for better implementation at the district level, timely completion of projects, and addressing gaps in governance that slow down progress. Special attention was also given to issues such as land management, employment generation, and capacity building, with a shared view that targeted, time-bound interventions in these priority areas are essential to accelerate inclusive and sustainable growth across Arunachal Pradesh.
