Governor meets DoNER Minister

Governor requests for DoNER Minister's support for the development of a dedicated football stadium in the State Capital, along with the establishment of an Integrated Sports Complex and State Sports Academies in the western and eastern regions of the State

Governor advocates for the establishment of an Integrated Pack House equipped with solar-based cold storage facilities

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.), met the Union Minister for Development of North Eastern Region (DoNER), Shri Jyotiraditya M. Scindia, in New Delhi on 15th April 2026. They discussed strengthening key sectors, particularly sports infrastructure and agro-horticulture, to accelerate development by empowering youth and leveraging the State's agricultural strengths for inclusive and sustainable growth.

Emphasizing the immense potential of Arunachal Pradesh's youth in games and sports, the Governor underlined the need for modern and accessible sporting facilities to nurture talent and promote excellence. He requested the Minister's support for the development of a dedicated football stadium in the State Capital, along with the establishment of an Integrated Sports Complex and State Sports Academies in the western and eastern regions of the State. He also stressed the importance of creating adequate sports infrastructure within higher educational institutions to encourage greater participation and competitive exposure among young athletes.

On the agro-horticulture front, the Governor highlighted Arunachal Pradesh's growing prominence in kiwi cultivation, noting its potential as a unique agricultural strength of the State. He sought expeditious approval of the proposal 'Kiwi as USP in Arunachal Pradesh' under the North Eastern Council (NEC), aimed at enhancing production, value addition, and market linkages.

Further, the Governor advocated for the establishment of an Integrated Pack House equipped with solar-based cold storage facilities at the Shergaon Horticulture Farm in West Kameng district. Such infrastructure, he said, would significantly improve post-harvest management, reduce losses, and boost farmers' incomes.
