APARC Chairman calls on the Governor

Commission's recommendations should focus on promoting greater accountability, ensuring transparency in government functioning, and improving administrative efficiency through meaningful civil service reforms: Governor

The Chairman of the Arunachal Pradesh Administrative Reforms Commission (APARC), Shri Pramod Jain, called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.), at Lok Bhavan, Itanagar, on 23rd June 2026.
