Governor condoles, calls for preparedness

The Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.), has expressed deep grief over the tragic loss of life caused by the flash flood in Keyi Panyor district. He also expressed concern for those who are still missing and prayed for their safe recovery. Wishing a speedy and complete recovery to the injured, the Governor conveyed his solidarity with all affected families during this difficult time.

Calling for proactive measures, the Governor directed the district administration and all concerned departments to remain on high alert and strengthen preparedness for the monsoon season. He urged officials to identify vulnerable locations, closely monitor weather conditions, and ensure timely dissemination of advisories to people residing in flood-prone and landslide-prone areas.

The Governor also instructed the State machinery, disaster management authorities, and the Border Roads Organisation (BRO) to work in close coordination to keep vital road communication networks open and free from landslide debris. Maintaining uninterrupted connectivity, particularly in remote and border areas, is essential for the movement of rescue teams, emergency services, essential supplies, and public convenience during the monsoon months, he said.
