Chief Minister calls on the Governor

The Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh, Shri Pema Khandu, called on the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh, Lt Gen KT Parnaik, PVSM, UYSM, YSM (Retd.), at Lok Bhavan, Itanagar, on 30 June 2026. The Chief Minister briefed the Governor on the prevailing flood situation in different parts of the State and apprised him of the measures being undertaken by the Government to provide relief and ensure the safety of affected communities. They also discussed various developmental programmes and key initiatives aimed at accelerating the State's socio-economic progress.

Expressing concern over the impact of floods on lives, livelihoods, and infrastructure, the Governor emphasized the need for a 'Whole of the State' approach to effectively address the challenges posed by the natural calamity. He underscored the importance of coordinated efforts among government departments, district administrations, community organizations, and citizens to strengthen disaster response and resilience.

The Governor commended the dedicated services of the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF), district administrations, Public Works, Civil Aviation and Disaster Management departments, the Indian Red Cross Society, volunteers, and local residents for their tireless efforts in relief, rescue, and rehabilitation operations.

The Governor also shared his observations from recent review meetings held at Lok Bhavan on important issues concerning the State, including the State Finances Audit Report, measures for ensuring the safety and protection of women and children, and ongoing cleanliness and sanitation initiatives being undertaken by the Itanagar Municipal Corporation. He also expressed his concerns regarding the unruly incident at NERIST.

The Chief Minister apprised the Governor of the ongoing activities being undertaken by various State departments, highlighting efforts aimed at improving governance, accelerating development, and enhancing public welfare across Arunachal Pradesh.
